PENNDOT Topics

- There was some discussion regarding CS 4171 and 4171S forms. Are there written directions or detailed guidelines to complete and file these forms? PennDOT says that there are instructions available with the form on their website.
- The precaster is required to contact the GC regarding Buy America goals for the project.
- Can PennDOT clarify the “Buy America” section? Does PA Act 3 make it necessary to forward all receipts and invoices to PennDOT inspection or simply have these records on file?
- Does the precaster need to maintain the files for 3 years or send to the job site?
- Receipts showing steel usage must accompany forms sent with shipments.
- It is currently not an option to upload any documents from the precaster to the website.

- CS-110 changed –effective February 2019 – for partial payment.

- Can PennDOT and PPA work on communication regarding updated forms such as these as well as upcoming CTs?

- Currently Bulletin 15 does not notify updated forms to all suppliers.
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- Spotted lantern fly permits are required if you move products or vehicles in or out of any of the 13 quarantined counties (Berks, Bucks, Carbon, Chester, Delaware, Lancaster, Lebanon, Lehigh Monroe, Montgomery, Northampton, Philadelphia & Schuylkill), you need to have a permit. Inspections began May 1.
