## PENNDOT Topics

- There was some discussion regarding the changes to Pub 145.
- Joe Bracken announced that Matt McSweeney had replaced Serge T and that they were adding personnel to the concrete team.
- The Department's list of precast Stock Item lists has mostly been cleaned up.
- Some discussion regarding Pub 145 Page 18 where the language restricts the amount of stock allowed to be made for inventory. Products are marked that are allocated to PennDOT projects and precaster tracks where every piece is headed.
- Discussion as to Pub 145 page 23 that specifies dry-fitting if there is a deviation in 2 pieces. To clarify, it does not necessitate dry-fitting all pieces at once to simulate the job conditions.
- Discussion regarding page 31 where pre-approved repairs are mandated. PennDOT said that precasters can get a modification approved by the EOR if necessary.
- Bracken updated the group as to specs that have been finalized: 1019 on coating/painting; 1044 on aesthetics includes staining precast concrete.
- Bracken stated that 50 box culverts installed under P3 are leaking. Most likely due to installation issues.
- The box culvert committee had a conference call on August 7, 2019 to discuss updated project lists and specification changes. As a result of some confusion in the minutes, PPA had to respond to District 3-0 to clarify a misconception about long lead times.
- Any final comments on MASH changes were due to PennDOT by September 6<sup>th</sup>.
