

State Highway 666 located in Sheffield Township, Warren County, Pennsylvania runs through the Allegheny National Forest. Due to the extremely long detour, this section of road could only be closed for one weekend or severe liquidated damages would be applied.

Mack Industries was able to provide the precast concrete box sections over Dodge Run. The inlet and outlet sections were delivered to the site one day before work was scheduled to begin in July of 2017. The SR 0666 project was complete and open to traffic in 56 hours from start to finish. Communication between the contractor and Mack Industries personnel lead to a smooth installation. The contractor, engineer, and Pennsylvania DOT were all extremely satisfied with the final product.

Mack Industries provided four sided box culvert 13'x11'. The sections were a total of 43 LF. The 8 box culvert sections were cast along with precast wingwalls and fish baffles.
